Dinosaurs laid eggs like birds.


Some ate other dinosaurs. They were carnivores. Others ate only plants. They were herbivores.


The extinction of the dinosaurs is a great mystery. However, scientists have many theories. From the fall of a meteorite to the ice age.

There were many different kinds of dinosaurs:






